

Kathryn Remien, 83

Nov. 7, 1914 - Jan. 23, 1998

AVOCA - Kathryn Lucille Remien was born at Treynor, Nov. 7, 1914. She was the daughter of I.D. and Lola Parker Redman, and was one of nine children in the family. The family moved to Walnut, and Kathryn attended school in Walnut and graduated in 1932. Following her graduation she helped her father in the drug store in Walnut.

She married Claus Krambeck and they were the parents of two children, Carol Ann and Richard. They lived in several communities in Kansas and Iowa. She and her children moved to Minden, in 1945, to make her home with her parents who operated a drug store in Minden. She attended beauty school in Burlington, and then moved to Atlantic, where she worked at the Powder Puff Beauty Salon.

She married Robert Remien Jan. 24, 1951, in Co. Bluffs. They made their home on their farm near Walnut. In 1975, they retired from farming and moved to Avoca. She became a resident of the Oakland Manors Nursing Home in Oakland, March 26, 1997. She died at the home Jan. 23, 1998, at age 83 years, two months and 16 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents; seven brothers and sisters, Hazel Steele, LaVon Smith, Louise Thomas, Bud Redman, Ward Redman and two infant sisters. She is survived by her husband, Robert of Avoca; one daughter, Carol Ann (Dick) Hensley of Atlantic; one son, Rev. Richard Krambeck (Elaine) of Mo.
