HARLAN – LeRoy Delbert Remmick, son of Elvin and Adalian (Milbrett) Remmick, was born Oct. 17, 1943, and baptized in Portland, OR. The family moved to Minnesota for a short time and then to Lake View, where he grew to adulthood. He was confirmed at Emmanuel Lutheran Church in Lake View, and attended Lake View High School.
