

Veronica Rosman, 85

Feb. 2, 1917 - Nov. 11, 2002

COUNCIL BLUFFS – Veronica A. Rosman was born Feb. 2, 1917, in Jacksonville, FL, to Charles S. and Gertrude (Bendon) Gue. She previously lived in Harlan, moving to Council Bluffs in 1967. She was a 1940 graduate of Mercy Hospital School of Nursing. She was a registered nurse at Myrtue Hospital for 15 years and Mercy Hospital in Council Bluffs for 10 years, retiring in 1979. She was a member of St. Peter's Church, St. Ann's Altar & Rosary Society, and the Legion of Mary. She died Nov. 11, 2002, at Nebraska Methodist Hospital in Omaha, at age 85.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Myron, Dec. 24, 1978. Survivors include two daughters, Elaine Rosman of Council Bluffs and Mary Lou Crowder (Ben) of Cheyenne, WY; four sons, James Rosman (Edith) of Omaha; Rudy Rosman (Pat) of Madison, WI; William Rosman (Kathy) of Omaha and Steve Rosman (Pam) of Council Bluffs; one sister, Mary Gue of Council Bluffs; 16 grandchildren; 13 great grandchildren.
