Sept. 11, 1899 - Feb. 26, 1991

HARLAN - Sarah Luella Savereide, daughter of William and Laura (Musselman) Comstock was born Sept. 11, 1899, on a farm near Tennant. She attended country school through eighth grade, and graduated from Tennant High School. She then taught school for a time, and worked at the Harlan Coffee Shop.

April 14, 1922, she married Arthur Savereide in Harlan. Four daughters were born to this union. After their marriage, they made their home in Harlan. After the death of her husband, Feb. 5, 1980, she continued to live in her own home until May of 1990, when she became a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan. She died Feb. 26, 1991, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan, at age 91 years, five months and 15 days.

She was a member of First United Methodist Church in Harlan, and was a member of the United Methodist women; Zenobia Rebekah Lodge # 286 for over 50 years, and had been a Past Noble Grand, and Past President of Patriarchs Militant of the Rebekah Lodges of Iowa; and a 50 year member of the Order of Eastern Star, Lebanon Chapter #8, of Harlan.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by five sisters, Edith, Vera, Grace, Leatha, and Eva; and two



brothers, William, and Earl. Surviving her are her daughters, Dorothy Norgaard of Harlan; Marianne (Mrs Richard) Pauley of Lincoln, NE.; Patricia Pedersen of Milwaukee, WI., and Twyla (Mrs Ron) Plumb of Olathe, KS.; ten grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren; nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held March 1, 1991, at Pauley Funeral Home, with Rev. Janne A. Clinton and Rev. D. Stephen Clinton of First United Methodist Church in Harlan, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Eugene Gaer, Deane Blakeley, Kenneth Tucker, Robert D. Hansen, Bob Christensen, and Richard Petersen, casketbearers.
