HARLAN - Evelyn Francis Schack, daughter of Ernest and Minnie Herweg Thomas, was born Nov. 26, 1920, near Dunlap. She was raised and attended rural school in Harrison County. Nov. 11, 1941, she married George Schack at Harlan and to this union two sons were born. They lived in Harlan until 1955, then they moved to Marshalltown. They later moved to Des Moines where she worked for Meredith Publishing and in 1968 moved to Omaha, where she worked 14 years for Skagg Drug. She was an active member of the St. Andrew's Episcopal Church of Omaha. She died Nov. 19, 1988 at her home in Omaha at age 67 years, 11 months and 23 days.
