PANAMA - Services for Robert Schomer of Panama were Tuesday afternoon (May 31) at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Panama. Burial was at Panama St. Mary's Cemetery.

Schomer, 67, died Sat., May 28, 1988, at Bishop-Clarkson Memorial Hospital, Omaha, NE.
