Avoca - Anita Louise Schuemann was born in Avoca Oct. 4, 1913, the daughter of Hans and Mary Bramman Harder. She was one of five children in the family. She attended school in Avoca.

She married LeRoy Schuemann Aug. 4, 1934 at the Harder family home in Avoca. They started farming south of Avoca and then moved on the farm northeast of Avoca until LeRoy's death May 30, 1970. She then moved into Avoca to her present home. She worked as an Aide at the Colonial Manors Nursing Home until her retirement. She was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church in Avoca. She died at Clarkson Hospital in Omaha, NE Jan. 7, 1995 after a very brief illness at age 81 years, 3 months and 3 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents and her husband, LeRoy. She is survived by her son, Marty Schuemann (JoAnn) of Avoca, two granddaughters; four great-grandchildren, three sisters; Elinor Mohr of Avoca, Frances Welton of Lincoln, NE, Rosemary (Everette) Bauer of Normal, IL and a brother, Max Harder (Betty) of Riverside, CA, nieces, nephews and other relatives.
