

Thomas Howard Schuster (Scottie), 82

Aug. 3, 1910 — March 19, 1993

BEAVER DAM, WI. — Thomas Howard Schuster (known as Scottie) died March 19, 1993 at Beaver Dam, WI. He was born near Shelby, Aug. 3, 1910, son of Alfred and Anna Leslie Schuster. He graduated from the Shelby High School in 1929, attended Iowa University and graduated from the School of Pharmacy in 1934.

He married Mildred E. Clauson at Iowa City in 1934, the couple had two sons, Charles Alfred and Howard Craig. He practiced pharmacy in Anamosa, Clinton, and Dubuque, was a detail man for Parke Davis and Co. in Chicago, IL., and managed a Walgreen store. In 1949, he established a drug store in Shelby which burned to the ground in 1959 of unknown origin. He also owned a drugstore in Avoca during the late fifties. In 1960, he purchased a drugstore in Winterset and operated it until his retirement in 1972. They lived in Des Moines for awhile and later moved to Beaver Dam, WI., to be close to their family.

He was preceded in death by his parents; son Craig and brother Ronald.

Surviving are his wife, Mildred; 1 son, Charles (Shirley) of Juneau, WI.; 4 grandchildren; 1 sister, Mildred Bair (Jerry) of Atlantic.

Burial services were April 10, 1993 at the Shelby cemetery with Rev. Gerald Oliver of the Shelby Presbyterian Church officiating.
