NEWELL — Cliff Shinn was born March 1, 1904, at Woodbine. He was the son of Moses and Sarah (Welsh) Shinn. He graduated from Woodbine High School in 1924 and attended Iowa State University. He began farming in the Woodbine area.

June 10, 1928, he married Dorothy C. Lewis at Woodbine. The couple farmed near Woodbine until 1942, when they began farming in Buena Vista County. Dorothy died in 1956. He worked as a feed salesman in the West-Central Iowa area. In 1962 he married Fay Aljets at Pomeroy. The couple made their home in Fort Dodge. In 1983, he retired at the age of 80. In 1985, they retired to Manson until March of 1992, when they entered the Good Samaritan Center at Newell.

He was preceded in death by his first wife, Dorothy; step-son, Dennis Aljets and four sisters.
