DUNLAP - Leonard P. Sondag, 61, of Omaha, a former Dunlap resident, died Nov. 15 at Methodist Hospital in Omaha.

He was born near Dunlap and graduated from St. Joseph Catholic School in 1953. He worked at the Omaha Stockyards from 1955 until 1957, served for two years in the U.S. Army and then returned to work at the stockyards. He retired in July because of poor health.
