

Albert Wilton Sorensen, 91

Oct. 12, 1902 - Jan. 3, 1994

Walnut - Albert Wilton Sorensen was born in Shelby County Oct. 12, 1902. He was the son of E. Adam Sorensen and Libby Arentsen. He was one of five children born to this union. He attended country school at the Cuppys Grove school.

He married Mabel Christensen Feb. 2, 1927 at the Christensen family home in Harlan. They made their home on their farm in the Cuppys Grove area of Shelby County. They were the parents of three children, Marjorie, Lavonne and Eugene. He was a member of the Calvary Baptist Church in Walnut. They remained on the family farm until Dec. 1980, when they moved to the Peace Haven Home in Walnut. Mabel died June 22, 1985. Albert died at the Clarkson Hospital in Omaha, NE Jan. 3, 1994, following a brief illness, at age 91 years, 2 months and 21 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, Mabel, his son, Eugene, two sons-in-law; Wayne Sorensen and John Anderson, two brothers; Lloyd Sorensen and Clifford Sorensen and one sister; Mabel Sorensen.
