HARLAN — Christian Peter Sorensen was born in Hormested, Denmark Feb. 15, 1936. He was the son of Marius and Jenny Hejlesen Sorensen. He was one of six children in the family. The family came to the U.S. in 1946 and settled in Avoca. He attended school in Avoca.

He married Barbara Madsen Nov. 30, 1958. They were the parents of four children. He farmed for a few years until he became employed by the Western Engineering Company in Harlan where he worked as a truck foreman, until his health failed and he was no longer able to work. He died at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan Jan. 29, 1992 at age 55 years, 11 months and 14 days.

He was preceded in death by his father and one son, Chris.
