HARLAN - William Frederick Stamp, son of L.H. Edmond and Edna Stamp was born Dec. 7, 1935, near Persia. He attended high school in Persia and received a Bachelor of Science in business administration from the University of Nebraska at Omaha in 1961. Dec. 9, 1957, he married Marilyn Jensen at Glenwood. He was an accountant and C.P.A. in the Harlan area before coming to Harlan in 1967, when he started his own accounting practice. He has worked for the past two years in Omaha with the Omaha 66 Service, Inc. He was a member of the Harlan Congregational Church and Church of Christ. He died Sept. 16, 1990, at the Clarkson Hospital in Omaha, at age 54 years, 9 months and 10 days.

Survivors include his wife, Marilyn of Harlan; two sons, Mark of Lubbock, TX., and Dean of Co. Bluffs; two daughters, Patricia (Mrs. Ronald) Smith of Co. Bluffs and Shanon Stamp at home. His parents, L.H. and Edna Stamp of Persia; two brothers, John of Persia and Jim of Longwood, CO., and a sister; Joan (Mrs. Stanley) Martens of Portsmouth; two grandchildren and many nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Sept. 19, 1990 at the Burnside Lutheran Home with Rev. Dennis Brayman and Rev. Brian Jensen, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Jack Stamp, Kurt Stamp, Kent Stamp, Russ Brooks, Bruce Havick and Bob Anastasi serving as casket bearers.
