

Hattie Steckelberg, 91

July 13, 1900 — May 10, 1992

HARLAN — Hattie Steckelberg, daughter of William and Melanie (Schoening) Schwieso, was born July 13, 1900 in Manilla.

Jan. 26, 1921, she married Henry Steckelberg in Manilla. To this union, four children were born. From 1921-1967, the couple farmed. They moved to Menlo in 1967 and lived there for ten years. Henry died in 1977, and she moved to Westridge Apartments in Harlan in 1978. She was baptized and confirmed at Trinity Lutheran Church in Manilla, and had been a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Harlan since 1978. She died May 10, 1992, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital, at age 91 years, 9 months and 27 days.

Preceding her in death were her parents; her husband, Henry; six brothers; three sisters; and one grandson. Survivors include two sons, Robert (Alice) of Harlan and Lester (Norma) of Menlo; two daughters, Lorene (Laverne) Brue of Irwin and Viola (Lester) Hass of Manilla; one brother, Edward Schwieso of Irwin; one sister, Bernadine Christensen of Manilla; ten grandchildren; 30 great-grandchildren; four great-great-grandchildren and many nieces and nephews.
