FORT DODGE - Opal Sophi Boge was born Nov. 8, 1912, in Persia. She attended Persia country schools and graduated from Persia High School in 1931. She attended Iowa Teacher's College in Cedar Falls and Buena Vista.

She married Alfred Schipull in 1948. The couple moved to Fort Dodge in 1956 after having farmed near Hardy and Lone Rock. She taught school at Persia, Livermore, Hardy, Truesdale and Fort Dodge. She retired from teaching in 1978. She was a member of the Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, a past member of the Fort Dodge Women's Garden Club, Rock Club, D.O.E.S. and a charter member of the Inner Guard. She died Oct. 2, 1997 at the Villa Care Center.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Alfred in 1988; her parents; sister, Velma Wiggins, and brothers, Henry and Ralph Boge. Survivors include her sister, Freda Gates, Fort Dodge, and several nieces and nephews.

Services were held Oct. 6, 1997, at Gunderson Funeral Home with the Rev. G.L. Milbrath of St. Olaf Lutheran Church officiating. Burial was in North Lawn Cemetery.
