

## **Dorthea Schlicht, 86**

*Sept. 6, 1916 – Dec. 23, 2001*

**WALNUT** – Dorthea Marie Timm was born Sept. 6, 1916, in Millard, NE, to Carl and Christina Paul Timm. She was baptized at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Millard and confirmed at the Trinity Lutheran Church in Avoca. She graduated from Avoca High School in May 1934.

She married Marvin Schlicht Sept. 30, 1935. They started farming while living on the flat in Avoca, later moving to Hamburg. In 1949, they returned to the century old Schlicht farm near Walnut, where they retired and presently lived. Dorthea was a Girl Scout leader. She died at her home Dec. 23, 2001, at age 86 years, three months and 17 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents; a half brother, Toby Christensen, and a foster brother, Arnold Timm. She is survived by her husband, Marvin of Walnut; four children, Arletta (Eugene) Larsen of Kirkman; Janice (John) Montony of Meridian, ID; Judy Schlicht of Des Moines and Jerry Schlicht of Elliot; nine grandchildren; seven great grandchildren and other relatives.
