

Florence I. Schornhorst, 70

July 4, 1928 - Oct. 16, 1998

BLUE EYE, MO - Florence I. Schornhorst, 70, of Blue Eye, MO, formerly of Waverly, died Oct. 16, 1998, as the result of a car accident in Blue Eye, MO. She was born July 4, 1928, in Oak Park, IL, the daughter of Eldo and Mildred Krefft Schornhorst. She was baptized in Oak Park and later confirmed at St. John Lutheran Church, Waverly, March 29, 1942.

She graduated from Waverly High School in 1946, then attended the University of Northern Iowa, Cedar Falls, where she received her BA degree in 1950. She then taught for two years in Eagle Grove, two years in Waterloo and one year at MacAllister College in the Twin Cities. Furthering her education, she went to the University of North Dakota where she received her master's degree in education in 1957. She became Dean of Women at Doane College in Crete, NE, where she stayed for two years. In 1959, she took a teaching position at the Washington High School in Cedar Rapids, where she stayed until 1987, when she retired to Twin Island Estates, Blue Eye, MO (Big Branson).

She was preceded in death by her mother in 1988. Survivors include her father of Waverly; a brother, Eldo Schornhorst, Jr. (DaMaris) of Harlan; a nephew, Steven Schornhorst (Doris) of Iowa City; a niece, Joyce Edfors (Thomas) of Lake Mills, WI, and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Oct. 20, 1998, at Stumpff Funeral Home in Kimberling City, MO and Oct. 22, 1998, at Kaiser-Corson Funeral Home, Waverly, with Pastor Gary Arp officiating. Burial was in Harlington Cemetery, Waverly.
