

## Lois Ann Schultz, 78

*Sept. 5, 1920 – July 19, 1999*

**HARLAN** – Lois Ann Schultz, daughter of Lake and Sarah (Haskins) Havick, was born Sept. 5, 1920, in Harlan. She grew up on a farm near Harlan and graduated from Harlan High School in 1938. She lived in Des Moines from 1938-1995, when she became a resident of the Elm Crest Retirement Community.

June 3, 1945, she married William H. Schultz in Des Moines. He died April 10, 1976, in Des Moines. Lois did community service, especially through P.E.O. in Des Moines. She died July 19, 1999, at the Elm Crest Retirement Community at age 78 years, 10 months and 14 days.
