

## Paul F. Scott, 73

July 10, 1926 - Nov. 24, 1999

**HARLAN** - Paul Frederick Scott, son of Harriett (Nielsen) and Rasmus Scott, was born July 10, 1926, at Harlan. He was baptized and confirmed at Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Jacksonville, and attended school at Center Township #4 in Shelby County.

He married June Doris Swensen June 30, 1948, at Immanuel Lutheran Church, Harlan. The couple began farming 2 1/2 miles east of Harlan. One of his loves was operating the caterpillar as it was needed in the farming operation. Serving his country during the Korean War from 1952-1953, he was a member of the U.S. Army 24th Infantry Division. He returned to Harlan following the war and expanded his farming operation retiring from farming in 1988. He was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 941 in Harlan and also a member of the American Legion Helmer Reyelt Post 150 and the American Veterans. In addition, he was an avid pilot, hunter and fisherman. He died Nov. 24, 1999, at his home at age 73 years, four months and 14 days.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, Margaret. Survivors include his wife June of Harlan; his brother, Norman Scott (Edith) of Manilla; his sister, Shirley Hansen of Harlan; nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Nov. 27, 1999, at the Pauley Funeral Home with Reverend Henry Flessner officiating. Military rites were conducted in the Jacksonville Cemetery with Michael Jensen, Bruce Heilesen, Dalton Jensen, Doug Svendsen, Dar Lund and Terry Koppold casket bearers.
