

Rose Marie Segol, 69

Nov. 26, 1928 - Sept. 5, 1998

GREEN VALLEY, AZ - Rose Marie was born Nov. 26, 1928, in Harlan, to Raymond and Lovie Fiscus. She joined a two year old brother, Victor Ray (also known as Jr. Ray). They grew up on the family farm a mile west of Fiscus. She attended high school in Harlan and following graduation in 1946, she enrolled in the nurses training school at Clarkson Hospital in Omaha, NE, and graduated a registered nurse three years later. She worked in South Bend, IN and Denver, CO, before going to San Francisco, CA, to work at Mt. Sinai Hospital.



Nov. 25, 1955, she married Mike Segol and they made their home in San Carlos and commuted to San Francisco daily to work. In 1983 she retired from her job as a bookkeeper for several doctors and Mike retired from the family importing business and the car leasing business. They sold their home and moved to Green Valley, AZ, to a golfing retirement community which they have enjoyed the last 15 years. At the end of June, 1998, she was diagnosed with advanced cancer. Aug. 25 she entered a hospice house in Green Valley, where she died Sept. 5, 1998 at age 69.

Preceding her in death were her father and mother; her father-in-law and mother-in-law and her brother-in-law, Fred Holloway of Kirkman. She is survived by her husband, Mike Segol of Green Valley, AZ; her brother, Victor Ray Fiscus of Tucson, AZ; her sister, Donna Holloway of Harlan; her brother-in-law, Martin Segol and family of the San Francisco area; her sister-in-law, Myrna and family of Washington, D.C. and nieces, nephews and other relatives.
