Stanley Allen Sheehan, 50

July 31, 1948 - May 15, 1999

HARLAN - Stanley Allen Sheehan, son of Paul Patrick and Dorothy (Parker) Sheehan, was born July 31, 1948, in Chicago, IL. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Robert Bellarmine Catholic Church in Chicago. He attended St. Robert Bellarmine Grade School and was a graduate of St. Patrick/Taft High School. He was employed as a trade show contractor and was responsible for setting up trade shows in Chicago and several other cities. In 1997, he traveled to Ireland with his father and brothers. Stan liked being with his family at their summer home in Lake Geneva, WI and had just purchased a bus to convert to a camper and was looking forward to spending a part of the summer camping with Jamie, Casey and Brian. He died May 15, 1999, at Harlan, at age 50 years, nine months and 15 days.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his brother, Joe Sheehan. Survivors include his daughters, Kathleen Sheehan of Niles, IL; Becky Sheehan of Orange County, CA; his sons, Jamie, Casey and Brian Sheehan, all of Harlan; his brothers, Paul Sheehan (Marge) of Wheaton, IL; and Robert Sheehan (Jo) of Arlington Heights, IL, and other relatives.

Funeral services were held May 20, 1999, at the Pauley Funeral Home with Rev. Howard Fitzgerald officiating. A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated May 22, 1999, at Immaculate Conception Church in Chicago, IL. Burial was in All Saints Cemetery in Des Plaines, IL.
