SHENANDOAH — Richard "Dick"

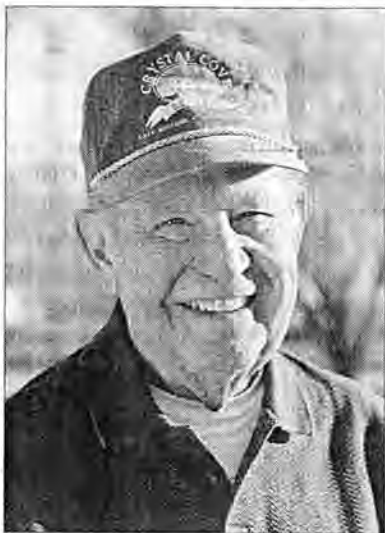
Lowell Siebels was born on December 24, 1941 to Elmer and Helen (Nielsen) Siebels in Council Bluffs. He attended school in Minden and graduated with the Class of 1961 from Minden High School.

September 1, 1962, Dick was united in marriage to Joan Nash. Two daughters were born to this union: Trisha and Tami. Dick entered the United States Army in October of 1966 and served on active duty for two years in Korea before transferring to the Army Reserves. He received his honorable discharge on October 2, 1972.

Dick was married to Victoria Moore on December 1, 1990 in Las Vegas, NV. He spent four years as a lineman apprentice at Iowa Power and Lights. He worked as an electrician, lineman, and line crew foreman before going into management and becoming a supervisor in 1995 for MidAmerican Energy when they moved to Shenandoah. He retired after forty-five years with the company. Dick loved to fish and went ice fishing in Minnesota with his buddies over Super Bowl weekend. In addition to fishing in Minnesota, he would go to South Dakota and Canada. He enjoyed gambling and golfing but his favorite pastime was being with his family. He loved to be with his kids, grandkids, and nieces and nephews and thought the world of his family. He talked a lot about them and was proud of them. Dick was a lifetime member of the United Church of Christ in Minden as well as the Minden Legion, Southwest Iowa Last Man Club, IBEW Local 499, and the Elks in Shenandoah. Dick died at his home on Tuesday, September 4, 2012 having attained the age of seventy years, eight months, and eleven days.

Dick was preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by his wife Vicky Siebels of Shenandoah, daughters Trisha and her husband Vern Johnson of LaVista, NE and Tami and her husband Dan Hinsley of Council Bluffs; step-daughter Mishelle and her husband Shane Light of Honey Creek; three grandchildren: Cortney and Cole Johnson and Tyler Hinsley; one step-grandchildren Katie Hinsley; brother Bob Siebels and his wife Sharon of Minden; a special nephew Keith Siebels and special niece Karen Eckmann; other family members and many friends.
