

Alfred L. Sorensen, 70

Sept. 17, 1934 - June 23, 2005

McMURRAY, PA — Dr. Alfred Lee Sorensen, son of Dr. Alfred Sorensen and Ella Heifesen-Sorensen, was born Sept. 17, 1934, in Price, UT. Alfred grew up in Harlan and attended schools here, graduating in 1953. He was active in many activities at Harlan High School, also at the Methodist Church and in Demolay.

He was a graduate of the medical school at the State University of Iowa and completed his internship and residencies at Ohio State University. His medical specialty was Dermatology. During his Ohio State residency period he was called to serve in the 82nd Airborne Division as a captain in the paratroops.

While at SUI, he met and married Sandra Mull in 1957. They were blessed with the birth of two sons, Gregory A. Sorensen and Kevin Eric Sorensen. In 1968, Dr. Sorensen began a 32-year dermatology practice in the area around Washington, PA. He was a member of the Washington and Canonsburg hospital staffs. He was actively involved with the Washington Area Humane Society. Alfred died at his home in Pennsylvania June 23, 2005, at age 70 years, nine months and six days.

Preceding Alfred in death were his parents. Survivors include his wife, Sandra Sorensen of McMurray, PA; two sons, Greg (Galena) Sorensen of Tulsa, OK and Eric Sorensen of Pittsburg, PA; three grandchildren, Cassandra, Brandy and Kate; one sister, Mary Sorensen-Mitchell of Ouray, CO; and many other relatives and friends.

Private internment of ashes was held Sept. 17, 2005, near his mother's gravesite in the Harlan Cemetery. Memorial services followed at First United Methodist Church with Rev. Dave Swinton officiating.
