

## **Eileen Ostebee Sporrer, 48**

**Nov. 10, 1957 - Dec. 4, 2005**

**Easley, SC** – Eileen Ostebee Sporrer was born in Audubon, the daughter of Viola Asmus Ostebee and Magnus Ostebee. She was a self employed massage therapist and a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church where she sang in the church choir and belonged to the Adult Bible Study Class. She was also a member of One Voice, a Christian singing group in Sullivan, IL. She raised and trained AQHA Champion Quarter Horses. Eileen was the 1977 Audubon County Fair Queen, a member of 4-H, and was the first female member of FFA in the State of Iowa. She died Dec. 4, 2005 at St. Francis Hospital in Greenville, SC at age 48.



In addition to her father, Eileen was preceded in death by a brother, Eugene Ostebee. Surviving are her husband, Ron Sporrer of Easley, SC; her daughter, Lindsey Sporrer (18) of Clemson University; her son, Kyle Sporrer (15) at home; her mother, Viola Ostebee of Audubon, a brother, Merlene Ostebee (Joyce) of Audubon; and other relatives.
