PERSIA — Janice Eileen Stuhr, the daughter of Wilfred and Arlene Sick Stinn, was born May 29, 1942, on a farm outside of Portsmouth. She attended Leland Grove Country School and was a member of the graduating class of 1960 from Harlan Community High School in Harlan.

May 31, 1962, Janice married Robert Stuhr at Council Bluffs. After high school, she worked at the First National Bank in Council Bluffs. Three children were born to this union: Linda, Kathy and Donna. In 1966, she began waitressing. She also re-finished antiques in a partnership with her sister, Joyce, called J&J Antiques. She died June 4, 2005, at Jennie Edmundson Hospital in Council Bluffs at age 63 years and six days.
