Julius Wareberg, 91

March 23, 1905 - July 28, 1996

IRWIN - Julius Wareberg, son of Bartel and Anna (Norbie) Wareberg, was born March 23, 1905, in Armstrong. He was raised in and around Kandiyohi County, MN, and attended public schools there. In the early 1930's, he moved to Irwin, where he worked as a farm truck driver for Roy Larson.

May 8, 1934, he married Bernice Carolyn Olsen in Irwin. From the early 1940's until his retirement in 1970, he was employed by Steenhusen Hardware in Irwin. He entered the Manilla Manor in Feb. 1995. He became a resident of Eventide Lutheran Home in Denison, in Jan. 1996. His wife, Bernice, died June 15, 1996. He was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Irwin. He died July 28, 1996, at Jennie Edmundson Hospital at age 91 years, four months and five days.

Preceding him in death were his parents; his wife, Bernice; two brothers, Nels Wareberg, at age two and Bernard Wareberg; and three sisters, Isabell Axland, Dagne Hall and Beulah Ward. Survivors include one son, Alvin Wareberg of Denison; one daughter, Nancy (Dennis) Anderson of Vancouver, WA; two sisters, Nora Wilham of Minneapolis, MN and Agnes Appel of Seattle, WA; three grandchildren and two great grandchildren and other relatives.

Funeral services were held July 31, 1996, at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Irwin, with Pastor W. Clayton Nielsen officiating. Casket bearers were Orrin Bruhn, Larry Knudson, Gilbert Hanson, Edwin Benson, Loren Ostebee and Gailard Knudson. Burial was in the Danway Cemetery, rural Shelby County.
