EARLING - Mildred Marie Wheatley, daughter of John and Alpha (Johns) Vogelgesang, was born April 19, 1912 at Lima, OH. As a small girl, she moved with her family to Omaha, NE. She attended school in Omaha, graduating from North High School. After school, she became employed for Woodman of the World where she worked for many years.

April 20, 1939, she married Vernon Wheatley. After their marriage, they moved to California where she was employed in the shipyards as a C.P.A. during WW II. They eventually moved back to Marne, where they operated a general store. After selling the store later on, they then moved back to California where she continued working as an accountant. After retiring from her accounting job, she sold antiques for several years. After the death of her husband Feb. 14, 1994, she continued to reside in California until March of 1995, when she moved to Portsmouth to make her home with her daughter. In July of 1996, she became a resident of the Little Flower Haven Nursing Home in Earling. It was there that she died Dec. 21, 1996, at age 84 years, eight months and two days. She was a Past Worthy Matron and 50 year member of OES Liberty Chapter, Marne.

She was preceded in death by her parents and husband. She is survived by her daughter, Shirley (Omer) Scheffler of Portsmouth; two grandchildren and six great grandchildren.
