HARLAN - Clementine E. Wilson, the daughter of Cavender and Isabell (Hansen) Gaer was born Dec. 18, 1908, in Harlan. She died on Oct. 8, 1989 at Immanuel Medical Center in Omaha, NE., at age 80 years, nine months and 20 days. She was baptized in the Church of Christ at an early age, and graduated from Harlan High School. She attended Iowa State Teachers College in Cedar Falls and then taught school in rural schools in Shelby Co.

On Sept. 17, 1932, she married Howard Wilson of Tennant. In 1936, they moved to CA., to make their home. She worked in a printing shop for many years, and later became Comtroller of the Orange County Hospital. After the death of her husband in Jan. of 1977, she continued to make her home in CA., and traveled extensively. She had recently returned to Harlan to make her home at the Baptist Memorial Home.

She was a member member of the Harlan Church of Christ. She was currently a member of Northside Church of Christ in Santa Ana, CA.; the American Business Women's Association; and was active in the Republican Party.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband; and two brothers, Adolph and Russell. Surviving her are two brothers, Cortland Gaer of San Diego, CA.; and Cavender Gaer of Spirit Lake; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Oct. 11, 1989 at Pauley Funeral Home with Roy North of the Harlan Church of Christ officiating. Burial was in Harlan cemetery with Bill Lambert, Howard Gaer, Douglas F. Gaer, Gordon Petersen, Daryt Christensen and Elwood Christensen serving as casket-bearers.
