

Dwight Heim Wuster, 78

Walnut - Dwight Heim Wuster was born near Dawson, NE on April 23, 1916, son of Thomas F. and Maggie Heim Wuster and was one of eight children in the family. He attended Dawson High School and graduated in 1935.

He married Lilah Wachtler Nov. 24, 1938 in Dawson, NE. They were the parents of one son, Rodney. He worked in the banking industry in NE until 1958, and he served as Mayor of Dawson. He moved to Walnut in 1958, where he was a Vice President in the Walnut Bank until his retirement in 1978. He served as Secretary of the Walnut School Board from 1959 to 1972, served as Community Club president, was caretaker of the Walnut museum, and worked for Knutson Funeral Home in Walnut. He was a member of the Presbyterian Church, sang with the church choirs for 50 years, was a member of the Historical Society and the Masons. He and Lilah moved to Peace Haven Retirement Home in 1993. He died Nov. 2, 1994 at the Cass County Memorial Hospital in Atlantic, at age 78 years, 5 months and 10 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents, three brothers and three sisters. He is survived by his wife, Lilah, his son, Rodney Wuster of Carter Lake and a sister, Erva Stalder of Falls City, NE and other relatives.

Memorial services were held Nov. 5, 1994 at the First Presbyterian Church, Walnut, with Rev. Gerald Oliver officiating. Inurnment was in the Heim cemetery, Dawson, NE.
