# *Accident claims life of Harlan woman*

**ELK HORN** -- An 87-year-old Harlan woman was killed in a one-vehicle accident northwest of here Sunday evening, May 16.

Florence L. White, died Monday morning as a result of injuries sustained in the accident.

According to Shelby County Sheriff reports, a 1988 Chevrolet driven by Florence White's daughter, Connie, 60, was northbound on Umbrella Road about 7:30 p.m. Sunday when it veered out of control.

The accident occurred about 1/2-mile south of 700th St. on Umbrella Road.

The vehicle slid into the ditch and rolled onto its top. The car was listed as a total loss.

Both Connie and Florence White were transported to Myrtue Memorial Hospital, Harlan, by Elk Horn Rescue and Medivac Ambulance/Rescue.

Connie White, Omaha, was treated and released from Myrtue Hospital. Florence White was flown by Lifenet Helicopter to the University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha, where she later died.

Funeral services will be held Wednesday, May 19 at 1 p.m. at Pauley Jones Funeral Home in Harlan for Florence White
