

## **Dennis Whyte, 63**

*Sept. 26, 1938 - Sept. 25, 2002*

**WALNUT** – Dennis Edward Whyte was born Sept. 26, 1938, in Council Bluffs, son of Thomas and Margaret Brougham Whyte and was one of four children in the family. He attended school at Oakland, and graduated from Oakland High School with the Class of 1956.
