HARLAN — Lily Margaret Woods, the daughter of Elmer and Mable (Fox) Peck, was born November 17, 1922 at Elliott and died July 3, 2013 at the Elm Crest Retirement Community in Harlan at the age of 90 years, 7 months, and 16 days. Lily attended school in Elliott and graduated from Elliot High School with the class of 1940.

March 4, 1951, Lily was united in marriage to George Wayne Woods at Elliott. They moved northwest of Elliott where they farmed. Lily later worked at Mom's Café and then John's Café in Griswold. George died in 1988. Lily moved to Griswold in 1990 and then to Harlan in 2004. Lily was a member of the Elliott United Methodist Church. She had been very active on the farm, helping with the livestock and harvesting the crop. Lily was a very dedicated mother and never missed any of her children's activities.
