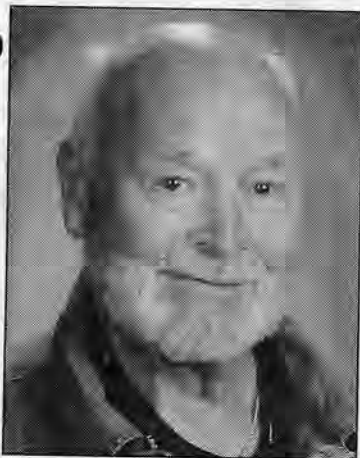


William "Bill"

Bill attended Fort Dodge Community Schools in Fort Dodge graduating with the High School Class of 1955. After graduation, he moved to Chicago where he was employed as a tree trimmer and worked at Goodyear Tire for several years before moving back to Fort Dodge. He was then employed at the Hormel

Plant in Fort Dodge for a few years before making his home in Harlan where he worked at American Beef in Oakland for several years.

Bill and his family enjoyed traveling to their cabin at the Lake of the Ozarks where he never gave up the opportunity to be driving the boat. But most of all he loved to spend time with his family.
